LEGEND OF THE WHITE SNAKE

CHANG'E AND HER MOON PALACE

The legend of Chang'e tells of a beautiful woman married to the archer Hou Yi, who saved the world by shooting down nine suns. After receiving an elixir of immortality, Chang'e drank it to protect it from the greedy apprentice Peng Meng, transforming into the Moon Goddess and floating to the moon. Heartbroken, Hou Yi searched for her, but she remained unreachable. In her honor, people celebrate the Mid-Autumn Festival with mooncakes and offerings, keeping alive the story of love and sacrifice.

FLOWER BLOSSOM

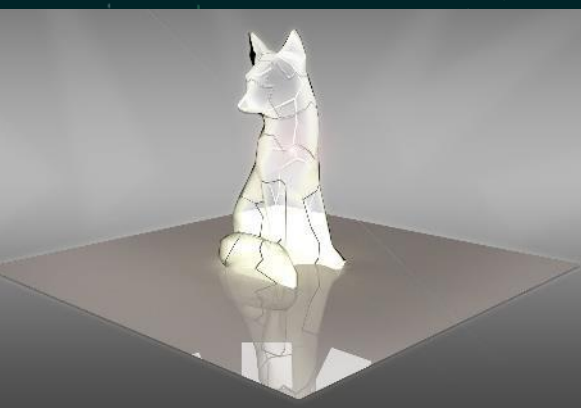

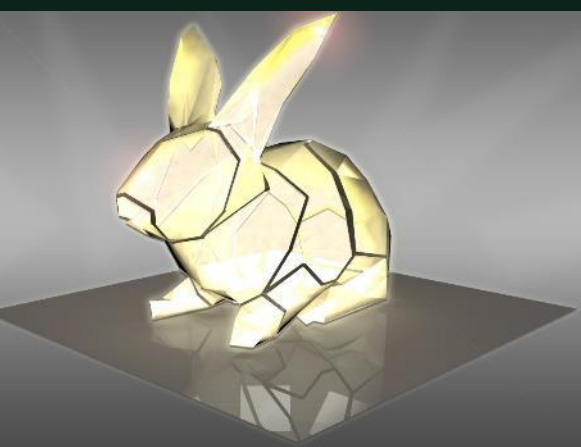

FOX ORIGAMI LANTERN

The fox (Kitsune) origami lantern pays homage to the legendary Japanese creature, the Kitsune, which takes the form of a fox and is renowned for its beautiful tail. As a prominent figure in Japanese mythology since the Heian period, the Kitsune symbolizes intelligence and longevity, often being described as "intelligent as a fox." This lantern, with its intricate fox-shaped design, serves as a captivating representation of the Kitsune's mythical allure and enduring significance in Japanese culture.



RABBIT ORIGAMI LANTERN

The rabbit (Usagi) origami lantern embodies the symbolism of cleverness, self-devotion, and the arrival of Spring. In ancient folklore, the rabbit is revered as a creature of intelligence and is associated with the rejuvenation of nature during the Spring season. Crafted with delicate folds and intricate details, this lantern captures the essence of the rabbit's significance in myths and traditions, making it a charming symbol of renewal and wisdom.

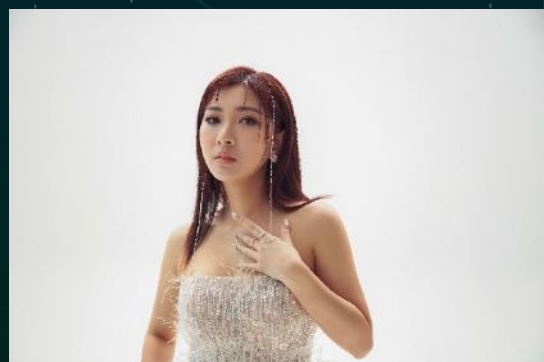

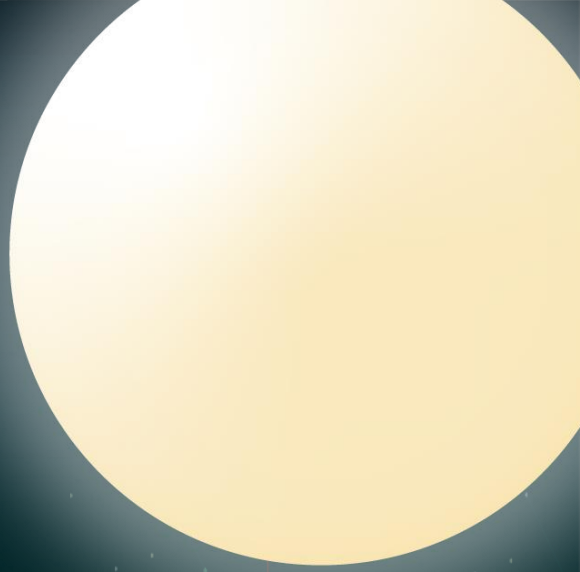
